



Symptoms that need IMMEDIATE MA triage

1. Start with the patient's PCP/MA.
 2. If PCP is unavailable, then get the MA on call.
 3. If she is unavailable, grab any MA.
- **Chest Pain** or pressure, feeling 'like an elephant is sitting on their chest'
 - **Shortness of breath**, or any trouble breathing
 - **Fainting**
 - **Slurred speech, facial drooping**
 - **Sudden problems walking**
 - **Headache with vomiting or vision changes**, or **sudden onset** of severe headache
 - Allergic reaction: **facial/lip swelling**, tongue swelling, troubles breathing (rashes can wait)
 - **Swollen leg (one side)** with a hard lump - especially if has had recent travel where they were sitting for a long time (flight, car ride, etc)
 - **Concussion**
 - **Changes in skin color, lips, hands**
 - **Abdominal Pain**
